## Renewal of Registration Audit

I am writing to you in relation to the application from Biba Academy of Hair & Beauty Pty Ltd t/as Biba Academy of Hairdressing for renewal of registration as a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) pursuant to Part 4.3 of the *Education and Training Reform Act 2006 (the Act)*. It is a condition of *the Act* that an RTO must comply with the *Australian Quality Training Framework 2007: Essential Standards for Registration (AQTF 2007 Standards)*.

An independent audit was conducted on 9 July 2010 to assess the compliance of Biba Academy of Hairdressing with the *AQTF 2007 Standards* for the purpose of renewal of registration. I note that you have accepted the findings of the audit in full. I enclose a copy of the final audit report for your attention.

In accordance with the AQTF 2007 National Guideline for Risk Management and the AQTF 2007 National Guideline for Managing Non-Compliance, the findings of the audit report indicate significant non-compliance with the following AQTF 2007 Standards:

- Standard 1.1 The RTO collects, analyses and acts on relevant data for continuous improvement of training and assessment.
- Standard 1.2 Strategies for training and assessment meet the requirements of the relevant Training Package or accredited course and are developed in consultation with industry stakeholders.
- Standard 1.3 Staff, facilities, equipment, and training and assessment materials used by the RTO are consistent with the requirements of the Training Package or accredited course and the RTO's own training and assessment strategies.
- Standard 1.4 Training and assessment are conducted by trainers and assessors who:
  - (a) have the necessary training and assessment competencies as determined by the National Quality Council or its successors
  - (b) have the relevant vocational competencies at least to the level being delivered or assessed
  - (c) continue developing their vocational and training and assessment competencies to support continuous improvements in delivery of the RTO's services.

Standard 1.5 Assessment, including Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL):

(a) meets the requirements of the relevant Training Package or accredited course

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- (b) is conducted in accordance with the principles of assessment and the rules of evidence
- (c) meets workplace and, where relevant, regulatory requirements.
- Standard 2.1 The RTO continuously improves client services by collecting, analysing and acting on relevant data.
- Standard 3.1 The RTO uses a systematic and continuous improvement approach to the management of operations.
- Standard 3.3 The RTO manages records to ensure their accuracy and integrity.
- Condition 6 Certification and issuing of qualifications and Statements of Attainment

Given the significant non-compliance of Biba Academy of Hairdressing as an RTO, you are required under Part 4.3.17 of *the Act* to provide within **28 days** of receiving this correspondence documented evidence of how non-compliance has been rectified.

In anticipation of a comprehensive and satisfactory response, I have renewed the registration of Biba Academy of Hairdressing as an RTO until 31 July 2015.
