Biba uses a learning management system (LMS) for online course delivery. The following are the minimum information technology requirements to enable optimal access to the LMS: Have one of the following operating systems: Windows98, ME, 2000, XP, Windows 10 Home and Professional edition, Vista or Windows 7 or Mac The following browsers are supported: Mozilla Firefox 4 and above, Internet Explorer 8 and above, Safari 5 and above, Google Chrome 11 and above and Opera 9 and above Web based content is available on hand-held devices including tablets. Learning Biba ensures that learning materials used in online training are presented in a variety of formats, including: **Materials** Guided content Graphics PowerPoint presentation Audio Interaction through discussion forums Course Notes - on Google Classroom and/or hard copy provided to students prior to subject commencement Student Biba provides an online learning experience that is engaging and interactive. We will monitor your participation and ensure that you continue to progress through **Engagement** your course. All students only access the learning content via online and for the majority of students this is accessed at Biba Academy when students are onsite for training. Students can access the learning content from anywhere and are encouraged to do so. Collaborative learning opportunities will be provided so that you can interact with peers, through Discussion forums Ongoing feedback will be provided as you study through: Interaction with trainers/assessors in informal discussion forums In response to individual queries We will contact students who have not logged on within 1 week of the subject commencement date. Students who have not logged on within 2 weeks of the subject commencement that do not engage after 3 attempts at contact will be deemed to have withdrawn from the subject.
